

DIRECTIONS TO:

Cody Horse Camp from Randle

In Randle, WA, at the intersection of U.S. Route 12 and State Route 131/Cispus Road (signal light) take Cispus Road south .9 mile to a "Y" intersection.

Bear left, staying on Cispus Road/Forest Route 12.

Go 17.7 miles to another "Y" intersection.

Bear left onto Forest Route 21.

Go 4.6 mile to an intersection and Walupt Lake sign.

Turn right onto Forest Route 56 (gravel).

Go 4.7 miles to Cody Horse Camp sign.

Turn right and go .2 miles to campground on left.

Cody Horse Camp is located about 29 miles southeast of Randle, Washington
Elevation, 3100 feet.

Open May 20 thru September 30. Weed free feed required. Presently, no fee, or NW Forest pass required.

Check with Cowlitz Valley District Ranger 360.497-1100.

The stock only campground features 16 pull-through campsites that accommodate large horse trailers – 4-horse with LQ., each with picnic tables, fire ring and highlines. There is plenty of wood available. There is a stock watering trough and hand pump in the center of camp, and manure bunkers to use if you don't want to pack it home. There also is a vault toilet and a large day-use area with a mounting assist ramp.

This camp is adjacent to the Klickitat trail system, and the Klickitat Horse Trail 7A which make a good loop day ride.

For a short ride from Cody you can ride up the mountain to Midway Meadow. For a long day ride from there you can ride over to Keenes, make the loop (via Spring Creek Trail) back to Midway, and back down to Cody. Or, out of Cody and up to the Crest. You can also leave Cody, cross the road then the river and ride out the other way.
