

DIRECTIONS TO:
KALAMA HORSE CAMP
(Northwest Forest pass required & Camp Fees)

Take Inter-State 5 South to Woodland.
Exit on State Route 503.
Go to Forest Rd 81 and turn left.
Follow the signs to Kalama Horse Camp.

Kalama horse camp has no reservations - it is on a first come basis. The camp is set up to handle approximately 100 horses, with 2, 4, and 6 horse corrals and some highline areas.

The campground provides 17 camp sites, suitable for double occupancy (two trucks and trailers), and 7 single family camp sites (one truck and trailer). Two group sites accommodate three to four families. Corrals and a high picket line are available.

Campground amenities include:

- Picnic area with horseshoe pit
- Group picnic shelter with stove
- Lounging area
- Loading ramp
- Staging area with stock water trough -
(Stock water is available, but not potable water for human use)
- Hitch rails
- Mounting assist area
- Bins for manure disposal

All campsites include a table, fire ring, and corral.

The campground loop trail allows easy access to the main trailhead. A trailhead parking area, found at the east end of the campground provides parking for day use.

Trails accessible from the camp include Trail 231,238, 237,242 and 204 which provide short and long rides. Over 50 miles of trails and closed roads are available from the campground.
