

DIRECTIONS TO:

Keenes Horse Camp - Mt. Adams

Weed Seed Free Feed is required. A Northwest Forest Pass is not required. There is no daily camping fee. It's free for now.

From Tacoma, take Hwy. 7 to Elbe.

Take a right in Elbe and go across bridge to Morton.

Turn Left on Hwy. 12.

Go to Randle to signal light. This is FS Road 23.

Turn Right.

Follow FS Road 23 to FS Road 21.

Turn left.

Go to FS Road 56.

Turn right.

Go to FS Road 5603.

Turn right.

Continue up the mountain to FS Road 2329.

Go right.

Keenes Horse Camp is about 2 miles up on the right.

The camp is located on Forest Road 2329 at Spring Creek.

NOTE: Be sure you don't get onto the Yakima Indian reservation. You'll be fined!

There is a loading ramp, high lines, a water trough, and vault toilets. Some units have tie stalls. No potable water. There are fire rings for each site.

The old loop has smaller, separate camp units. Access limited in old loop to Camper pickups with smaller trailers. The new loop has easy access. Larger rigs can fit in new loop. The units blend together.

Trails accessible from this area include Trails 7A, 13, 110, 112, 113, 114, 115, 116, 120, and 2000 (Pacific Crest Trail).

If you camp at Muddy Meadows a Northwest Forest Pass is required. Trail Head passes can be purchased at REI, on-line and the National Forest Service. There is a NFS building about 1 1/2 miles past Randle on Hwy. 12.
