

DIRECTIONS TO:

Lewis River Horse Camp
(Northwest Forest pass required & Camp Fees)

Take Inter-State 5 South to Woodland.
Exit on State Route 503 East.
Go thru Cougar.
Continue East on Forest Road 90 to Forest Road 93.
Turn left 1/8 mile.
Lewis River Horse Camp is on the right.

Kalama horse camp has no reservations - it is on a first come basis.

There are 9 camp sites and parking for 10 trailers and 15 vehicles. Pickup campers with trailers in mostly back-in sites. Larger rigs can camp in open parking area. Easy turning and parking. Roadways are paved.

There is a composting toilet, water nearby, table, and fire ring. There is a stock watering trough but no potable water.

There is a mounting assist ramp, and are high lines for stock at each campsite.

Trails accessible from the camp include Quartz Creek Trail 5 (plus 5B and 5C) and Lewis River Trail 31 which create additional access to Trails 1, 2, 3, 3A, 4, 17, 18, 19, 25, 80, and 80A. All of these are also open to mountain bikes and some allow motorcycles.
